#### Natural habitat

The natural range is really varied from plateaus of mountain regions to forests and valleys.

### Housing

Yemen Chameleons require a lot of ventilation, mesh / screen cages are usually recommended. It is important to provide plenty of horizontal branches for climbing and lots of broad leaf plants for cover.

The minimum enclosure sizes would be

61 x 61 x 122cm (23 x 23 x 48 inches)	46 x 46 x 92cm (18 x 18 x 36 inches)

### Heating

Yemen Chameleons will tolerate a wide range of temperature ranged but prefer a range of 23-35°C (75-95°F)

Basking spots maximum temperatures should be



Basking spot maximum	Ambient daytime range	Ambient night-time range
32°C (90°F)	24 - 26°C (85-80°F)	22°C (75°F)

The basking and ambient temperatures are easily achieved using Reptile Systems Basking Spot Lamps in combination with a Reptile Systems Medium Black Clamp lamp always remember to run basking spots lamps through a suitable dimming thermostat.

### Lighting

Yemen Chameleons fall into a Zone 3 under the Ferguson scale this ranges from 2.9 - 7.4 UVI the ideal photo period would be 12 hours with all the lights on and 12 hours with all the lights off.

The recommended temperatures and UVI are easily achieved using and Reptile Systems Zone 3 T5 / T8 Lamp.

## Yemen / Veiled Chameleon

*Chamaeleo calypratus*

### Substrate



Many keepers will not use a substrate with Chameleons due to them spending their time within the tree canopy, however it is important to provide female chameleons with a lay box which should be a 50:50 sand soil mix damp enough to hold a tunnel so that when she is ready she will have somewhere to lay.

If you do wish to dress the base of your enclosure then you can use a range of substrates such as orchid bark / cypress mulch, coir, and leaf litter.

### Water / humidity

Chameleon's are unlikely to drink from a water bowl, but they will drink from leaves or a dripper / misting system.

Yemen Chameleon's require an ambient humidity of 35 - 40% with humidity spikes twice a day of 85-90%.



### Diet / Nutrition



Yemen Chameleons are in the majority insectivorous and should be offered a wide variety of insects. It is important to remember to gut load your insects prior to feeding this can be easily achieved using Reptile Systems Insect Food.

Yemen chameleons will also eat plants, so it is important that any live plants used within an enclosure are non-toxic and it is recommended that they have access to a bowl of leafy greens / weeds / flowers.

Reptile Systems Calcium Ultra should be used 3 times a week as a dust on insects and Reptile Systems Vit-a-min should be used twice a week as a dust on insects (as a guide for adult animals).

### Handling

Yemen Chameleons can be handled, the temperament of each animal can vary so you will have to use your own judgment as to how much handling, if any, your individual pet will tolerate. With any new reptile it is suggested that a 2 week settling in period is given in which handling does not take place. Handling should be limited to 20-30 minutes at a time, so your animal does not get too cold.
